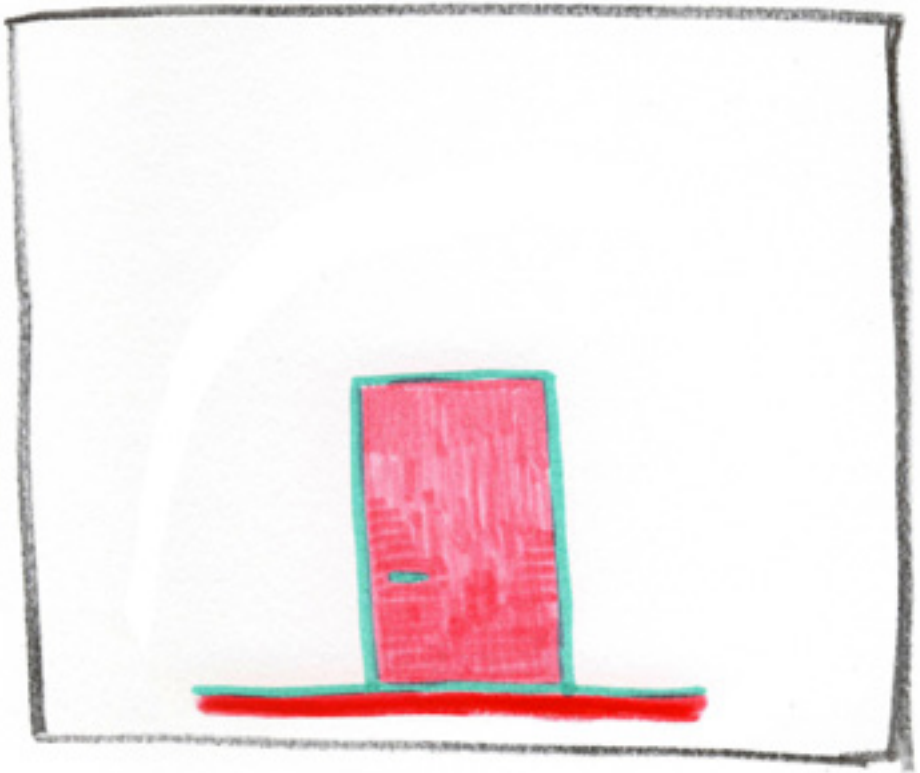
This book is an extraordinary exploration of the personal, political, and poetic. With over 200 pages of images and texts, it offers a deeply intimate yet wide-ranging meditation on art, weaving together the artist's experiences across two distinct cultural landscapes—her native Slovenia and her adopted home of Sweden.

The anthology of booklets, collected over years, captures the subtleties of contemporary life, including the clash of past and present, rural and urban, personal and communal. Through works like *THRIVE & CONSOLIDATE YOUR CAREER* (2020) and *THE CULTURE MINISTER'S FAVORITES* (2022), Slejko Blom explores the everyday with sharp humor and poignant vulnerability, while titles like *WE'RE PRETTIER THAN THEY ARE AND WE'RE INFINITELY GIDDIER* (2022) and *TWO WOMEN II* (2024) probe identity and human relationships in thought-provoking ways. Each piece is a stand-alone reflection, yet they form an interwoven narrative that challenges and invites the reader into a world both familiar and alien.

Dr Asta Vrečko is an assistant professor and research fellow at the Faculty of Arts, University of Ljubljana, where she obtained her doctorate in 2014 from the Department of Art History. She has more than ten years of experience in higher education institutions in culture and art. Her research and scientific work focuses on Slovenian and Yugoslavian art of the 20th century, with an emphasis on the organisation of artists, the history of exhibitions, and the cultural policy in the period of the two Yugoslavias, as well as concentration camp art. Vrečko has also been active as an art critic, cooperated with non-governmental organisations, and participated in several exhibitions and large projects organised by the main Slovenian cultural institutions and abroad, including the National Modern Art Museum in Zagreb. As a member of the curatorial team, she represented the Republic of Slovenia at the Venice Biennale of Architecture in 2021. Between 2018 and 2022, she was a municipal councillor for the Levica political party at the Municipality of Ljubljana, and a member of several municipal committees and cultural institution councils.



Parisa Liljestränd

Parisa Liljestränd (M) began her municipal political career as a 19-year-old and has been the chairman of the municipal board in Vallentuna, Sweden, since 2015. She has no experience of cultural policy at the national level and is a trained teacher and principal.

1. The government that appointed the minister has not yet found it worthwhile (or does not know how?) to teach Parisa Liljestrand the act of appearing less clueless in the field she is presiding over. Ever since her appointment, Liljestrand has been radiating professional inaptitude. Not familiar with the work of the likes of Ruben Östlund, she is the number one culture figure in a government that is planning to instill a new "culture canon" on its citizens.

2. This same government is marginalizing organizations working with nature protection, freedom of speech and human rights - the staples which used to be proud constituents of Swedish welfare state are now being shoved aside as unnecessary, special interests, opinion makers.

When CRD (Civil Rights Defenders) raised concerns over the Tidö Agreement* for its being in conflict with the international human rights conventions, SD's Björn Söder answered by demanding the withdrawal of the state funds to the organization.

*The Tidö Agreement is the written agreement among the right-wing parties forming the government, and the far right Sweden Democrats (SD) — this is the first time a far-right party has been given direct influence on government policy in Sweden.

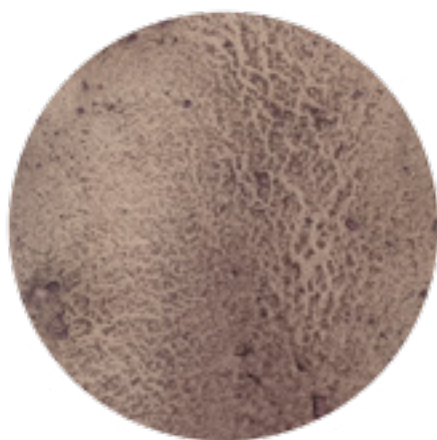

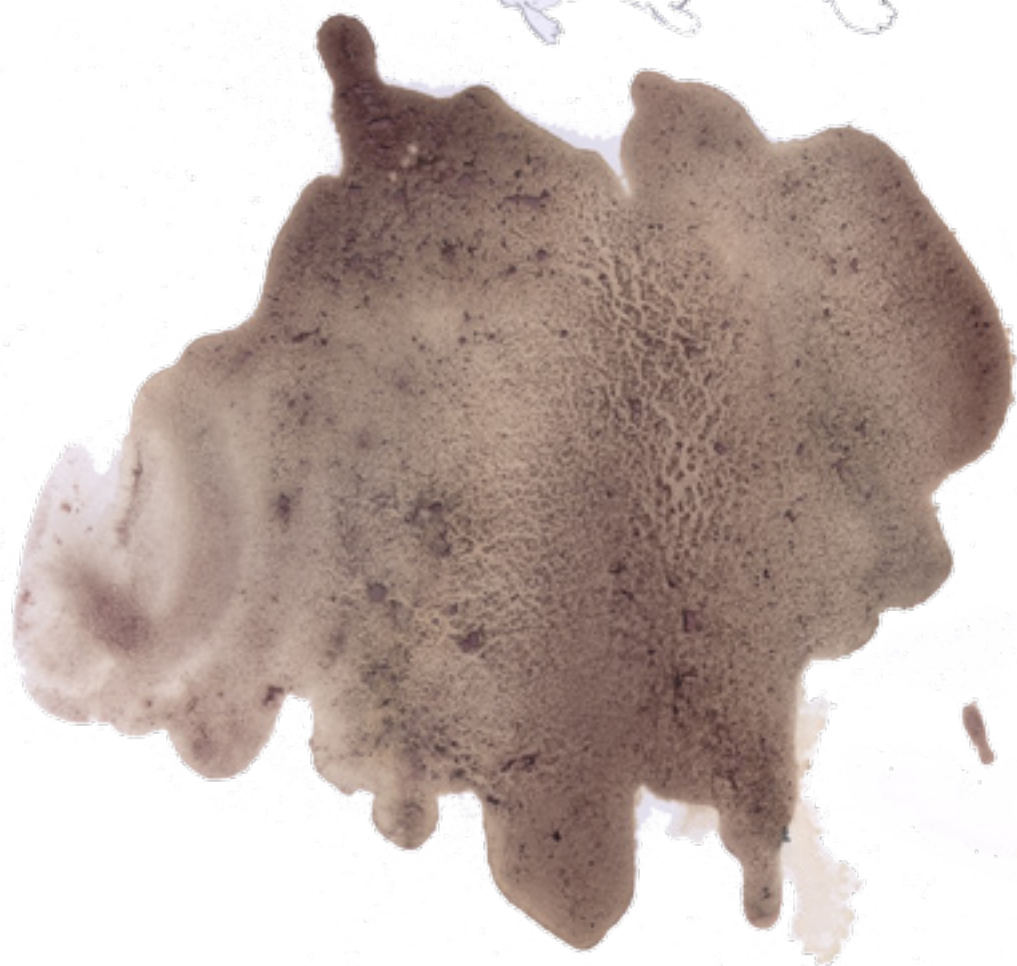

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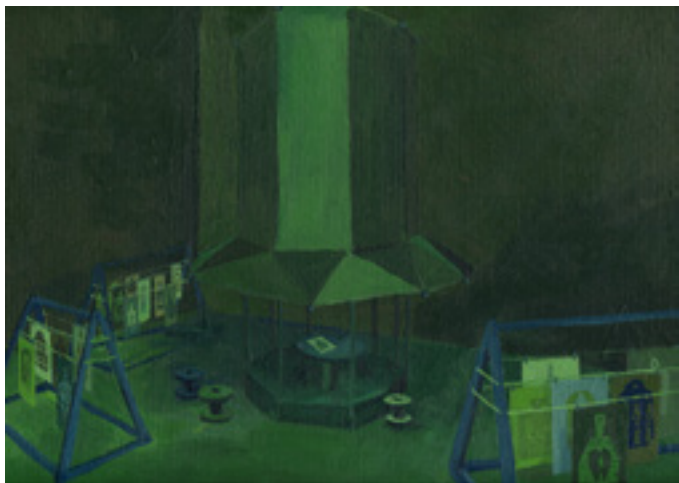
